Children will be able to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ask and answer a question: review questions and answers to introduce oneself (first person) • Say and write the nouns for members of the family: • Describe my family: father, mother, sister, brother, grand-father, grand-mother. • Say and write a sentence. • Use masculine and feminine agreement. • Engage in a simple conversation. • Ask and answer a question to say what subject I like or dislike • Use the conjunctions “et” and “mais” in writing. • Can express opinions (likes and dislikes). • Know months of the year • Learn how to write the date independently. • Role play a simple conversation with peers
