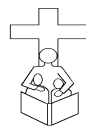
Monday 24th November

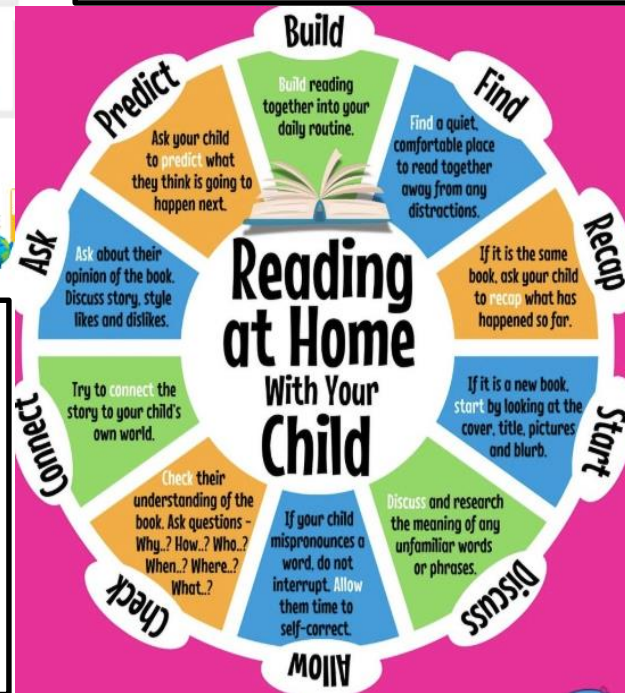
