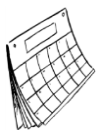

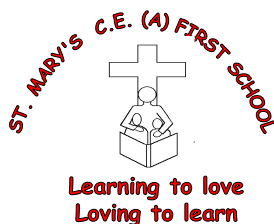
Our School Library
