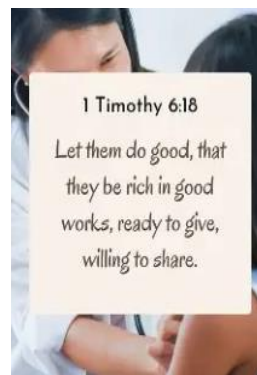
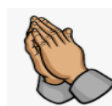
PTFA Annual General Meeting
