Autism Pyramid Group



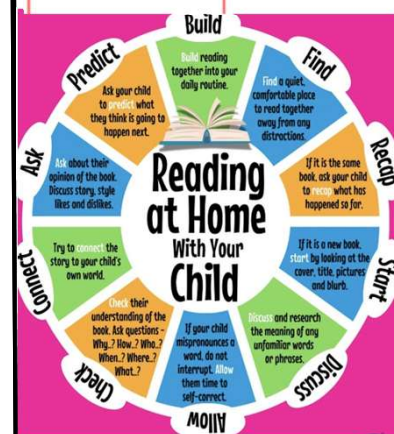
Supportive group for families
