Entry is at the back door of the Hall, and make sure your phones are not in use please. If your child is celebrating a birthday this week, you are welcome to join us!

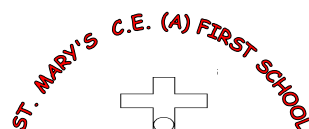
Meet the Teacher!
