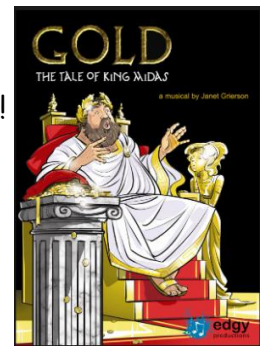
IF YOU WERE AN ENGINEER WHAT WOULD YOU DO
