the children won't be able to access outdoor learning, if they haven't got their wellies/old trousers/waterproof.



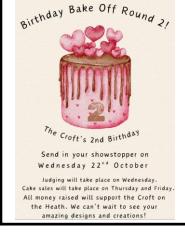
