



Autism Pyramid Group

If your child has autism, autistic traits and/or additional needs, you may want to meet up with other families who experience similar things to you.

The Autism Pyramid Group is a local organisation which helps families, providing support through their facebook page, Stay & Play sessions, parent coffee mornings and activities during the school holidays.

There are monthly Stay & Play sessions at The Heath Community Centre – the next one is this Sunday (19th Oct) 2.00-4.00pm

Threadworm

There have been cases of worms reported in school, so please check.....

Threadworms (pinworms) are tiny worms in poo. They are common in children, as they can often forget to wash hands after using the toilet, hands in pants, hands in mouth, touch everything around - so very easily spread! You can treat them without seeing a GP.

How to check.....You can spot worms in your poo. They look like pieces of white thread. You can buy medicine to treat threadworms from pharmacies. Treat everyone in your household, even if they do not have symptoms. Make sure everyone washes their hands. https://www.nhs.uk/conditions/threadworms/

Head Lice
