"we interacted online with engineers and I designed jetpacks to protect me."

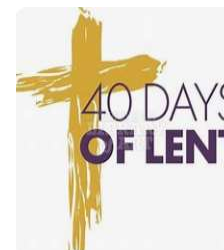
"I designed a machine to help doctors diagnose autism which would help so many people."
