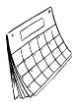

April is Autism Acceptance Month

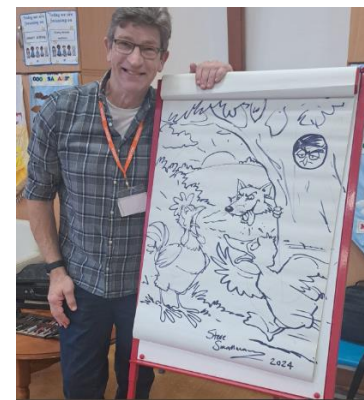


On Friday 26th April we will be having a Rainbow Day to celebrate Autism. We will wear our most colourful clothes and have a bake sale!
